FIREWORKS REMINDER!

City of Lake Waukomis Ordinance 274 limits use of fireworks in the City of Lake Waukomis. The ordinance details the type of fireworks prohibited & allows enforcement thereof. **Fireworks are allowed only on July 3rd & 4th between the hours of 10 am & 11 pm. Aerial fireworks are prohibited.** This includes fireworks that are projected or thrown. Audible devices limited to a 2 minute duration. Total discharge should not exceed 5 minutes. **Go to lakewaukomis.org to read the ordinance in its entirety.** Make sure you know the rules & inform your guests. Residents are responsible for their guests. Please be considerate so everyone will enjoy a safe & happy holiday! If problems, contact Platte County Dispatcher at 858-3521.

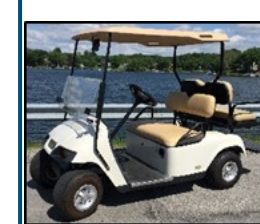
